Permit Conditions

1. Burn area must be at least 50 feet from any structure; home, shed, barn, garage, neighbor structure, business.
2. Permittee must call 480-945-6311 prior to burning to receive burn approval, and after burning each day.
3. No wind.
4. Fires can be started no earlier than one hour after sunrise. Burn must be extinguished at least two hours before sunset.
5. Pile shall be small, keeping to one pile no larger than 5ft x 5ft, and area around burn must be cleared.
6. Water hose shall be available and in reach of burn.
7. Permittee must attend fire at all times until it is completely extinguished.
8. Permittee must have a copy of this permit on-site during open burning.
9. Permittee must start fire using items that do not cause the production of black smoke.
10. Permittee can only conduct open burning during atmospheric conditions that:
 - a. Prevent dispersion of smoke into populated areas
 - b. Prevent visibility impairments on roads or at airports that result in a safety hazard
 - c. Do not create a public nuisance or adversely affect public safety

d. Do not cause uncontrollable spreading of the fire

11. Any public official may order that the burn be extinguished or may prohibit burning during periods of inadequate smoke dispersion, excessive visibility impairment, or extreme fire danger.

ARS 13-1706. It is unlawful for any person, without lawful authority, to intentionally, knowingly, recklessly or with criminal negligence to set or cause to be set on fire any wildland other than the person's own or permit a fire that was set or caused to be set by the person to pass from the person's own grounds to the grounds of another person. A person who violates this section is guilty of a class 1 misdemeanor, class 2 misdemeanor, class 3 felony or class 6 felony.

A burn permit does not relieve permittee of liability from damages or obligation to comply with other laws

I certify that I have knowledge of the facts herein set forth, that the same are true, accurate and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief. I further state that I will assume responsibility for conducting open burning in accordance with the Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 2 and any open burning permit issued thereof. HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

(BURN PERMIT)

The Crown King Fire District retains the right to inspect any potential burning sights as it deems necessary, without assuming any liability or responsibility, and may cancel a burn permit for any reasonable cause.
